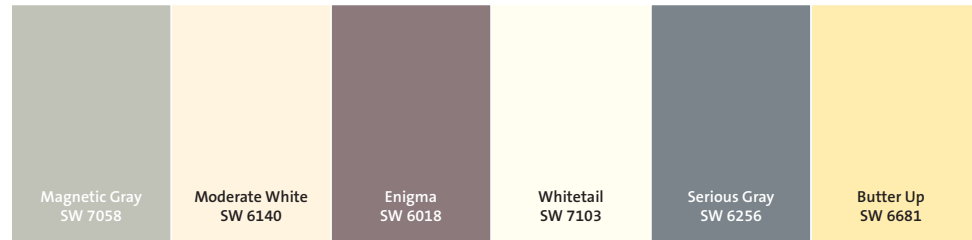
Translucent, Sophisticated, Structure
