The Project:

New 73,000 square foot building at the United States Military Academy in West Point, N.Y. provides Army's football team with state-of-the-art indoor practice facility.

Structural steel: Sherwin-Williams Pro-Cryl Universal Primer with DTM Acrylic topcoat

Concrete block: Loxon Conditioner with ProMar 200 Interior Latex Semi-Gloss topcoat

Metal doors: DTM Acrylic

The Challenge:

"We were given 23 days to prime and paint everything in the first phase, including all the structural steel, concrete block and sheetrock, but after some initial delays that was reduced to 18 days," says Bob Lombardi of Garrison Restoration. "The upper beams were 65 feet high and there were sometimes 13 or 14 aerial lifts in place that we had to work around. With a crew of 10 guys we got the painting done in 12 days." **PPC**

A Loveland, Colo. full-service hospital providing the region's most advanced cardiac and trauma care to patients from Northern Colorado, Wyoming and Nebraska. Private, homelike rooms have sofa sleepers and operable windows, free web access and same-floor kitchens and showers for family use. The hospital also offers views of Longs Peak, extensive daylighting, a four-story atrium, a rooftop terrace and healing gardens.

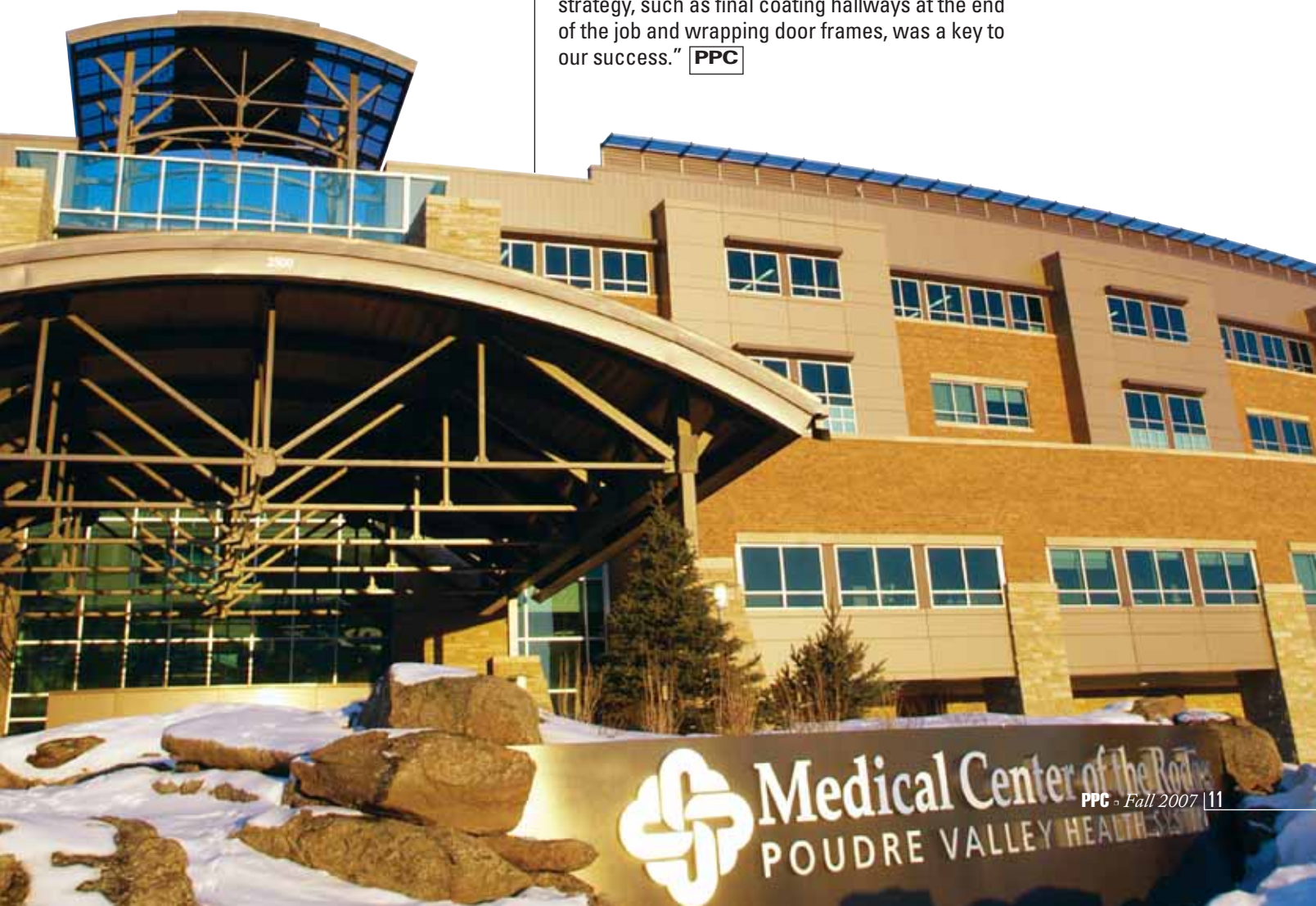
Trim: Sherwin-Williams DTM Acrylic Semi-Gloss

Total Gallons: 10,000

The Challenge:

The challenge was to provide a uniform finish that would touch-up well at the completion of a job that would take over a year to complete. "We switched to ProMar 200 Low Sheen and 12 months later the touch-up was superior," says Don Jones of Commercial Design. "A good exit strategy, such as final coating hallways at the end of the job and wrapping door frames, was a key to our success." **PPC**

New residential development tucked along Florida's Intracoastal Waterway in the beach town of Lantana. Included are seven town homes and 19 condominiums, each averaging around 2,400 square feet. The Rankin Gravett Group, owner of this new residential development, had an extremely tight timeline to complete the project. The company worked with Sherwin-Williams to spec Loxon XP, a high build coating that enabled Southern Painting to provide its client with excellent flexibility, durability and weather resistance in one coat. **PPC**



Saint Peter Church

The Project:

Interior repaint project using more than 350 gallons. As one of the few pre-Civil War structures still standing in the city, St. Peter's (www.historic-stpeters.org) is an important religious landmark in Cleveland, Ohio. Completed in 1859 from a plan by architects Heard and Porter, it's the oldest Catholic Church building in continuous use in the Diocese of Cleveland.

The Challenge:

The paint crew's biggest challenge was being able to see once they were on top of the scaffolding. "The scaffold was so high that light was very limited, and with spraying on white it was very hard to see what they had sprayed," says Matt West of Sherwin-Williams. "They really had to rely on their spraying experience and expertise. Some areas were hit three or four times to make sure the ceiling was covered. Spraying the peaks of the arches was almost like spraying in a cave."
